Ambassador Narong Sasitorn is a career diplomat. Prior to his assignment in Prague, he served in various offices in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Bangkok, Thailand. In 2007-2012, he was Consul General of Thailand in Chicago. In 2012, he was appointed a Director General of the Department of South Asian, Middle East and African Affairs and was later promoted to become a Deputy Permanent Secretary for Foreign Affairs in charge of bilateral affairs in 2013.

His previous portfolio includes Director of East Asian Affairs, Director of Personnel and Director of Policy and Planning. During 1987-1991, he served as a Second Secretary in the Permanent Mission of Thailand to the United Nations in New York. Later, he was assigned to the Royal Thai Embassy in Beijing, the People's Republic of China, in 1994-1997.
