

## REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVELLING TO THAILAND DURING COVID-19 SITUATION FOR NON-THAI CITIZENS

### Latest Updates (as of 11 January 2022)

1. All travellers wishing to enter Thailand must complete **pre-travel registration** via "Thailand Pass" (<http://tp.consular.go.th>) **at least 1 week before departure** (the registration requires approval by Thai health officers, who may reject registration with incomplete documents; it is NOT the same as Europe's fully-automated "Passengers Locator Form").

2. **Test and Go (no quarantine) scheme has been suspended until further notice**, except for those who have already received their Thailand Pass QR codes.

3. Travellers with existing Thailand Pass QR codes for the Test & Go scheme can benefit from the Test & Go (no quarantine) conditions. **At present, there is no cut-off date (deadline) for entering Thailand under Test & Go scheme** for those who already received Test & Go Thailand Pass QR codes.

4. Travellers who register via Thailand Pass registration system after 22 December 2021 **have 2 entry options:**

#### **(1) ALTERNATIVE QUARANTINE (AQ) SCHEME (available for those arriving in Bangkok and Phuket)**

- **7-day** quarantine at an AQ facility for **fully vaccinated** travellers (only for fully vaccinated travellers who received the second dose of vaccination for at least 14 days before departure).
- **10-day** quarantine at an AQ facility for **non-vaccinated** travellers.
- Travellers entering Phuket must arrive to Phuket directly from another country; transfer through Bangkok to Phuket is not possible.
- **Hotel reservation MUST be inclusive of 2 PCR tests, airport pick-up and 3 meals per day (full board) and must show the status PAID.**
- Please book your AQ hotel **directly with the hotel** (recommended) or via the following authorized platforms only: <https://asq.ascendtravel.com/>, <http://www.agoda.com/quarantineTH>, <https://asq.locanation.com/index.html>, <https://entrythailand.go.th/>.

#### **(2) SANDBOX PROGRAMMES (for fully-vaccinated travellers who received the second dose of vaccination for at least 14 days before departure)**

##### **PHUKET, KRABI & PHANG-NGA**

- No quarantine, but need to stay in the area for at least 7 days before travelling to other parts of Thailand.

- Need hotel reservation for at least 7 nights with **SHA Extra+ hotels** in **Phuket, Krabi or Phang-Nga**.
  - Within the 7-day period, change of hotel is possible only among hotels located in the same province.
  - Travellers may travel to other provinces (Phuket, Krabi, Phang-Nga) during the day as long as they return to sleep at their hotel.
- **Hotel reservation MUST be inclusive of airport pick up and must show the status PAID**. Booking confirmation issued by online agent, such as booking.com, **without airport pick up will be rejected**.
- Please book your SHA Extra+ hotel **directly with the hotel** (recommended) or via the following authorized platforms only: <https://asq.ascendtravel.com/>, <http://www.agoda.com/quarantineTH>, <https://asq.locanation.com/index.html>, <https://entrythailand.go.th/>.

- Must **book and pre-pay for their two RT-PCR tests** through <https://thailandpsas.com/> Travellers must upload the payment receipt issued through the PSAS system when registering for their Thailand Pass. **Without the said receipt, their Thailand Pass registration will be rejected**.
- **Travellers must arrive at Phuket International Airport directly from outside of Thailand**. They CANNOT arrive in Bangkok and connect their flights to Phuket, Krabi or Phang-Nga (but they can of course, transit through any other countries before arriving in Phuket). Those arriving in Bangkok will be required to enter quarantine in Bangkok under the Alternative Quarantine scheme.

## **SAMUI**

- No quarantine, but need to stay in the area (Samui, Koh Tao & Koh Phangan) for at least 7 days before travelling to other parts of Thailand.
- Need hotel reservation for at least 7 nights with **Samui Extra+ hotels or SHA Extra+ hotels**.
  - **At least the 1st night must be in Samui; other 6 nights can be in Samui, Koh Tao and/or Koh Phangan**.
  - After receiving negative PCR test result, travellers may leave their hotel in Samui to travel to Koh Tao and Koh Phangan.
- Please book your SHA Extra+ hotel **directly with the hotel** (recommended) or via the following authorized platforms only: <https://asq.ascendtravel.com/>, <http://www.agoda.com/quarantineTH>, <https://asq.locanation.com/index.html>, <https://entrythailand.go.th/>.

- **Hotel reservation MUST be inclusive of airport pick up and two RT-PCR tests and must show the status PAID.** Booking confirmation issued by online agent, such as booking.com, **without airport pick up & two RT-PCR tests will be rejected.**
- **Travellers must arrive at Samui International Airport directly from outside of Thailand.** Transfer through Bangkok is possible only with sealed routes flights (Bangkok Airways: PG5125 / PG5151 or PG 5171), which are booked together with the Europe-Bangkok flight in a SINGLE BOOKING issued by the airlines only. **Those who book domestic flight from Bangkok to Samui separately will not be allowed to travel to Samui, and will be required to enter quarantine in Bangkok.**

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR ENTERING THAILAND

(updated as of 10 January 2022)

*Disclaimer: Please make sure you have prepared all the required documents. It is the responsibility of the travellers to prepare the required documents to be presented to the relevant authority.*

Please prepare all documents that have been uploaded to the Thailand Pass online system in hardcopy, in case the Immigration Officer asks for the documents upon arrival in Thailand.

### 1. QR CODE generated through Thailand Pass Pre-Travel Registration System: <http://tp.consular.go.th>

- All travellers wishing to enter Thailand must complete pre-travel registration via "Thailand Pass" (<http://tp.consular.go.th>) **AT LEAST 7 DAYS BEFORE DEPARTURE.**
- Children under 18 travelling with parents should register for Thailand Pass QR Code together with their parents/guardians and not separately.
- **Problems with Thailand Pass Registration?** Try the following
  - Use non-hotmail/outlook email to register; the system does not yet support registrations with hotmail or outlook accounts.
  - Upload only JPG, JPEG or PNG files; PDF files are not supported.
  - Make sure that all files uploaded can be read clearly. Files that cannot be read will be rejected.
  - Make sure that you upload evidence of BOTH doses (1/2 & 2/2) of vaccination (except Johnson & Johnson). **Registration with only 2nd dose will be rejected.**
  - Make sure that you upload evidence of hotel reservation (with AQ or SHA Extra+ hotels) that includes airport pick-up and RT-PCR tests (please see hotel requirements below).

### 2. CERTIFICATE OF VACCINATION

- Issued by a government authority, containing personal information of the travellers (name, date of birth, passport number) and information on the vaccine (name, batch number, vaccination dates), in English language. Second dose of vaccination must be received for at least 14 days before departure.
- Without the certificate of vaccination, travellers are required to enter 10-day quarantine at an AQ hotel.
- **Accepted vaccines: Sinovac** (2 doses, 2 weeks apart) / **AstraZeneca** (2 doses, 4 weeks apart) / **Johnson & Johnson** (1 dose) / **Pfizer** (2 doses, 3 weeks apart) / **Moderna** (2 doses, 4 weeks apart) / **Sinopharm** (2 doses, 3 weeks apart) / **Sputnik V** (2 doses, 3 weeks apart).

- **If the duration between two doses are less than that set by the manufacturer**, the certificate of vaccination will be rejected.
- **Combination of different vaccines** is accepted provided that the period between 1st and 2nd dose was in accordance with the period set by the manufacture of the first dose.
- **Those infected and have recovered** with Covid-19 may present certificate of recovery together with evidence of 1 dose of vaccination administered after infection.
- If you have been fully vaccinated before contracting COVID-19, you are still considered to be fully vaccinated.
- **Children under 12** travelling with parents are exempted from having to present a certificate of vaccination.
- **Children above the age of 12 but under 18** are required to present a certificate of vaccination showing 1 dose of vaccination, unless they are travelling with parents, in which case they will be exempted from having to present a certificate of vaccination.

### **3. HOTEL CONFIRMATION that meets the requirements of the chosen scheme**

**TEST & GO (no quarantine):** fully-paid SHA Extra+ or Alternative Quarantine (AQ) hotel reservation for 1 night and evidence of payment for one RT-PCR test (**currently suspended, except those who registered for Thailand Pass before 22 December 2021**)

**SANDBOX PROGRAMMES (no quarantine but travel limited within designated area for 7 days):**

- Paid SHA Extra+ hotel reservation for at least 7 days, and evidence of payment for two RT-PCR tests & airport pick-up.
  - Those arriving in Thailand between 18.01-00.00 hrs will need to stay for **8 nights** (the day of arrival is counted as "Day Zero").
  - Those arriving in Thailand between 00.01-18.00 hrs will need to stay for 7 nights (the day of arrival is counted as "Day One").

- Phuket Sandbox requires **pre-payment for two RT-PCR tests through [www.thailandpsas.com](http://www.thailandpsas.com)**

**ALTERNATIVE QUARANTINE (7-day or 10-day quarantine):** AQ hotel booking for quarantine of **7 days** (for fully vaccinated travellers) or **10 days** (for unvaccinated travellers), **inclusive of two RT-PCR tests AND airport pick-up**, showing evidence of full pre-payment or deposit payment of no-less than 15,000 THB

**4. HEALTH INSURANCE** in English with a minimum coverage of 50,000 USD (only for non-Thai travellers)

- The insurance should cover the whole intended period of stay in Thailand.
- Travellers may purchase their health insurance which meets Thailand's entry criteria here: <http://covid19.tgia.org/>

**5. NEGATIVE RT-PCR TEST RESULT** issued no more than 72 hours before departure

- Children under 6 travelling with parents are exempted.
- **Those infected and have recovered with Covid-19** no less than 14 days but no longer than 3 months before departure may present a **Certificate of Recovery** in case the RT-PCR test result is positive (pls. check with your airlines if this rule applies for boarding the plane also).

**6. VALID VISA OR RE-ENTRY PERMIT**, unless the travellers are qualified for visa exemption scheme. Czech passport holders can enter Thailand with visa exemption if a period of stay does not exceed 30 days and with the tourism purpose.
