

REGULATIONS ON ENTRY TO THAILAND & COE APPLICATION

Non-Thai travellers are permitted to enter Thailand, provided that they have:

- **Certificate of Entry (COE)** issued by the Embassy (see application process below)
- **Valid visa or re-entry permit, unless the traveller is qualified for visa exemption** (for visa application process, please refer to <http://thaiembassy.cz/download.php?id=26>). Kindly note that the Royal Thai Embassy will accept visa application *by appointment only*.
- **Health insurance policy** (or "confirmation letter" issued by the insurance company) in English which expressly covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of 100,000 USD for the whole period of stay in Thailand (except for diplomats and representatives of foreign governments or international organizations, where "Letter of Guarantee" is needed). Travellers are advised to purchase their health insurance which meets Thailand's entry criteria here: <http://covid19.tgia.org/>
- **Medical Certificate with a laboratory result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected, using RT-PCR method**, which has been certified or issued no more than 72 hours before departure.
- **Hotel confirmation**
Confirmation of fully paid Alternative Quarantine (AQ) hotel booking for a 14-days quarantine (see options below) OR
Confirmation of fully paid SHA+ hotel reservation for 14 days, together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests for travellers applying for "Phuket Sandbox" programme (terms and conditions apply) OR
Confirmation of fully paid Samui Extra + & SHA+ hotel reservation for 14 days, together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests for travellers applying for "Samui Plus" programme (terms and conditions apply)
- **Travellers under "Phuket Sandbox" and "Samui Plus" programmes must present an additional document: Certification of Vaccination, in English (or with English translation)** issued by a government authority, containing personal information of the travellers (name, date of birth, passport number) and information on the vaccine (name, batch number, vaccination dates) (if applicable).

All travellers who have received COEs are required to download, and register via, ThailandPlus Application. They are required to show a QR code generated from the registration via the Application to be scanned by Thai authority upon arrival in Thailand (<https://thailandplus.in.th/en/>).

*** Travellers should avoid crowded or high-risk places at least 14 days before travelling to Thailand and they must wear masks while travelling. ***

ALTERNATIVE QUARANTINE MEASURES

REMARKS:

Those travelling to Thailand under "Phuket Sandbox" programme pls. visit "PHUKET SANDBOX PROGRAMME" for instructions.

Those travelling to Thailand under "Samui Plus" programme pls. visit "SAMUI PLUS PROGRAMME" for instructions.

All non-Thai foreigners (except those travelling to Thailand under "Phuket Sandbox" and "Samui Plus" programmes) are required to undergo mandatory quarantine stay at:

(1) **Alternative Quarantine (AQ) in Bangkok, Chonburi and Prachinburi** (for travellers arriving in Bangkok)

(2) **Alternative Quarantine (AQ) in Phuket and Phang-nga** (for travellers arriving in Phuket only; transfer from Bangkok to Phuket is not possible)

- AQ confirmation letter needs to indicate the booking type as AQ Package (inclusive of airport pick up, 3 meals daily and 2 times COVID-19).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS DURING COVID-19 SITUATION

Non-Thai nationals who are permitted to enter Thailand must present the following documents at check-in counter in the country of origin and at immigration control in Thailand:

- 1. CERTIFICATE OF ENTRY (COE) issued by the Embassy**
- 2. VALID VISA or RE-ENTRY PERMIT (except for those entering Thailand under Tourist Visa Exemption Scheme)**
- 3. HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY** (or "confirmation letter" issued by the insurance company) in English which expressly covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of 100,000USD for the whole period of stay in Thailand (except for diplomats and representatives of foreign governments or international organizations). Travellers are advised to purchase their health insurance which meets Thailand's entry criteria here: <http://covid19.tgia.org/>.
- 4. COVID-19 TEST RESULT** – medical certificate with a laboratory result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected, using RT-PCR method, which has been certified or issued no more than 72 hours before departure.
- 5. CONFIRMATION OF ALTERNATIVE QUARANTINE (AQ)** hotel booking for a 14-day quarantine OR **CONFIRMATION OF SHA+ HOTEL RESERVATION** for 14 days (together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests) for travellers entering Thailand under "**Phuket Sandbox**" programme OR **CONFIRMATION OF SAMUI EXTRA+ & SHA+ HOTEL RESERVATION** for 14 days (together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests) for travellers entering Thailand under "**Samui Plus**" programme.

- 8. DOWNLOAD "THAILANDPLUS" APPLICATION:** After receiving the COE, **all visitors are required to download the application "ThailandPlus" on their mobile phone and complete the registration before arrival in Thailand.** Upon arrival at a Thai airport, please show your QR code generated by the "ThailandPlus" application to the authorized officer. - 9. Travellers under "Phuket Sandbox" and "Samui Plus" programmes must present an additional document: CERTIFICATION OF VACCINATION, in English (or with English translation) issued by a government authority, containing personal information of the travellers (name, date of birth, passport number) and information on the vaccine (name, batch number, vaccination dates) (if applicable)**

HOW TO APPLY FOR CERTIFICATE OF ENTRY (COE) ONLINE

Non-Thai nationals travelling to Thailand need to apply for certificate of entry. **In order to apply for COE with the Royal Thai Embassy in Prague, the applicant must be present in the Czech Republic.**

***** Please apply for COE online at least 15 working days (3 weeks)
before your scheduled departure.*****

To apply, please:

(1) First, apply for an appropriate visa. For information on visa application procedures, please visit: <http://thaiembassy.cz/download.php?id=26> (Visa and COE Application During COVID-19 Situation). **If you already hold a valid Thai visa, please proceed to step (2).**

(2) Once visa has been issued, please proceed to completing COE application online: <https://coethailand.mfa.go.th/>

Please make sure that you have the following documents ready:

- **For pre-approval stage (Registration)**

- Copy of passport
- Copy of longterm or permanent residence in the Czech Republic (non-Czech nationals)
- Copy of valid visa or re-entry permit
- Health insurance policy (or "confirmation letter" issued by the insurance company) in English which expressly covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of 100,000 USD for the whole stay in Thailand (in English language).
- Declaration form
- Other documents to prove exempted status of non-Thai nationals (copy of marriage certificate for spouse of Thai national, copy of work permit for work permit holder, certification of vaccination etc.)

- **For final approval stage (Confirmation)**

- Flight confirmation
- Confirmation of fully paid Alternative Quarantine (AQ) hotel booking OR confirmation of fully paid SHA+ hotel reservation (together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests) for travellers applying for "Phuket Sandbox" programme OR confirmation of fully paid Samui Extra+ & SHA+ hotel reservation (together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests) for travellers applying for "Samui Plus" programme

(3) The COE application process is divided into two stages:

- **Pre-approval stage (Registration)**

- This is when the applicants are required to register for the COE by uploading a copy of their passports, valid visa or re-entry permit, Declaration form, Health insurance

policy covering COVID-19 and evidence of their exempted status. Upon completing the registration, applicants will receive a 6-digit code. Applicants must take note of this code which is needed for checking the status of their applications.

- If the applicants qualify for the COE and have provided all required documents, the Embassy will pre-approve their registration within 3 working days. The applicants can check the status of their registration by visiting <https://coethailand.mfa.go.th> and clicking the "check the result" tab.
- If documents are missing, the Embassy will reject the registration and the applicant will have to upload additional documents as per instruction. The Embassy reserves the right to request additional documents, as necessary.
- **Final approval stage (Confirmation)**
 - Once pre-approved, the applicants will have 15 days to confirm their flights and AQ/SHA+/Samui Extra+ hotel by uploading two additional documents: (1) flight confirmation and (2) confirmation of fully paid AQ hotel booking OR confirmation of fully paid SHA+ hotel reservation (together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests) for travellers applying for "Phuket Sandbox" programme OR confirmation of fully paid Samui Extra+ & SHA+ hotel reservation (together with evidence of pre-payment for required RT-PCR tests) for travellers applying for "Samui Plus" programme. To upload, please click the "confirm travel" tab on <https://coethailand.mfa.go.th>
 - Successful applicants can download COE directly from <https://coethailand.mfa.go.th> Please print out the COE and keep it for travelling.
- **Remarks**
 - Please do not upload flight confirmation and AQ/SHA+/Samui Extra+ hotel confirmation during the pre-approval (registration) stage.
 - **The COE is issued for specific flight and AQ/SHA+/Samui Extra+ hotel.** If the applicant changes flight and/or AQ/SHA+/Samui Extra+ hotel after receiving the COE, he/she must contact the Royal Thai Embassy (visa@thaiembassy.cz) for a new COE. The applicant will be given access to his/her old account on the COE application platform to amend flight/AQ/SHA+/Samui Extra+ hotel details and to re-apply for a new COE via the platform.
 - There is no fee for the application for a COE.

(4) Once COE is issued, the traveller should proceed to making an appointment with doctors/clinics to obtain:

- **COVID-19 test result**, with a laboratory output indicating that COVID-19 is not detected (COVID test must be by RT-PCR method), issued within 72 hours before departure (in case of connecting flights, before embarkation from initial port). In English language.
- **Download "THAILANDPLUS" APPLICATION:** After receiving the COE, **all visitors are required to download the application "ThailandPlus" on their mobile phone and complete the registration before arrival in Thailand.** Upon arrival at a Thai airport, please

show your QR code generated by the “ThailandPlus” application to the authorized officer.
