

TOURIST VISA EXEMPTION

- Passport holders of the countries eligible for Tourist Visa Exemption Scheme (see the list below) are not required to obtain a visa when entering Thailand for tourism purposes and will be permitted to stay in Thailand for a period of not exceeding 30 days on each visit.
- Foreigners who enter Thailand under this Tourist Visa Exemption Scheme may only do so for 30 days at one time with a maximum of 3 times in a 6-month period by flight and 2 times a year for overland crossing.
- Foreigners entering Thailand under the Tourist Visa Exemption scheme must show the documents listed below at the port of entry:
Proof of adequate finances for the duration of stay in Thailand i.e. traveller's cheque or cash equivalent to 20,000 Baht per person and 40,000 Baht per family.
Proof on onward travel (confirmed air, train, bus or boat tickets) to leave Thailand within 30 days of the arrival date (otherwise a tourist visa must be obtained).
- Please note that Tourist Visa Exemption does not apply to foreigners holding "Travel Document for Aliens" issued by these countries.

(****) Thailand holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil, the Republic of Korea and Peru. Therefore, nationals of these 3 countries are exempted from visa requirements and are permitted to enter and stay in Thailand for a period not exceeding 90 days.
