

## **WORK PERMIT HOLDER (non-immigrant visa, category B)**

Non-Thai nationals who are holders of a work permit or have been granted permission to work in Thailand in accordance with Thai laws, including their spouses or children, wishing to apply for visa shall apply **in person** at the Embassy after making the appointment at: [visa@thaiembassy.cz](mailto:visa@thaiembassy.cz), **at least 20 working days (4 weeks) prior to the departure.**

Documents for non-immigrant visa, category B, single entry only, are listed on page 2, 4 and 5 of the following document:
