

COURT APPEARANCE

to be a contestant or a witness for the judicial process (non-immigrant visa, category O)

Foreigners wishing to apply for visa shall apply **in person** at the Embassy after making the appointment at: visa@thaiembassy.cz, **at least 20 working days (4 weeks) prior to the departure.**

Documents for non-immigrant visa, category O, single entry only:

- **Passport** with validity at least 6 months from arrival to Thailand
- **Copy of passport**
- **Copy of longterm or permanent residence in the Czech Republic** (non-Czech nationals)
- **Visa application form** completely filled and signed
- **1 recent passport size photograph**, taken within the past six months
- **Ticket to and out of Thailand** or ticket reservation
- **Evidence of adequate finance** (15,000 CZK per person). Applicant can submit such evidence in form of bank statement or confirmation letter from the bank about final balance (name of the account's owner, balance and date must be shown) – in English language or with official translation to English.
- **Proof of accommodation in Thailand** for the whole period of stay in Thailand (after completing the Alternative Quarantine/SHA+ hotel stay)
- **Documents showing the participation in litigation or judicial proceedings** as complainant, the aggrieved party, accused, plaintiff, defendant. Confirmation letter from the inquiry officer in charge of the case or official letter or document from the authority concerned indicating that the applicant is involved in a case judicial proceeding.
- **Visa fee: 1600 CZK (paid in cash)**

Once the visa is issued travellers must register for Thailand Pass at tp.consular.go.th at least 7 days prior to departure. Without the Thailand Pass QR Code, they will be refused entry to Thailand.
