

TOURIST VISA EXEMPTION

Passport holders of the following countries/territory are not required to obtain a visa when entering Thailand for tourism purposes and will be permitted to stay in the Kingdom for a period of not exceeding **30 days on each visit** (please note that Tourist Visa Exemption does not apply to foreigners holding Travel Documents for Aliens issued by these countries):

Visa exemption conditions:

- Entering the Kingdom through land/sea border checkpoints under Tourist Visa Exemption Scheme is permitted only twice in a calendar year, except nationals of Malaysia, Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia and Singapore who may enter Thailand through such checkpoints more than twice in a calendar year.
- Travellers entering Thailand under the Tourist Visa Exemption Scheme must possess adequate cash of or equivalent to 20,000 Baht or 40,000 Baht per family.

Travellers must register for Thailand Pass at tp.consular.go.th at least 7 days prior to departure. Without the Thailand Pass QR Code, they will be refused entry to Thailand.
