

TOURISM PURPOSES until 30 September 2022

(special tourist visa, STV)

SPECIAL TOURIST VISA CONDITIONS:

- STV is valid for a single entry into Thailand for long-term tourism purposes only.
- STV is valid for 3 months from the date of issuance. Travellers must enter Thailand within the said 3-month period. They will be allowed to stay in Thailand for a period of up to 90 days, counting from the date of entry. STV may be extended twice while the visitor is in Thailand for a period of up to 90 days per each extension.
- STV cannot be changed to any other type of visa during the duration of stay in Thailand.
- If the STV holder breaches the entry conditions (for example if he/she engages in work-related activities), the stay permit will be revoked and he/she will be prohibited from entering Thailand in the future.

Non-Thai nationals wishing to apply for visa shall apply **in person** at the Embassy after making the appointment at: visa@thaiembassy.cz, **at least 20 working days (4 weeks) prior to the departure.**

Documents for STV:

- **Passport** with at least two empty pages and validity at least 12 months from arrival to Thailand
- **Copy of passport**
- **Copy of longterm or permanent residence in the Czech Republic** (non-Czech nationals)
- **Visa application form** completely filled and signed
- **1 recent passport size photograph**, taken within the past six months
- **Criminal record** – A letter verification issued from the country of applicant's nationality or residence stating that the applicant has no criminal record. The verification shall be valid for not more than three months, it must be notarized by the Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs and officially translated into English.
- **Medical certificate**, issued from the country where the application is submitted, showing no prohibitive diseases as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E. 2535). The certificate shall be valid for not more than three months. The form can be downloaded at:

After the medical certificate is confirmed by the medical doctor, the applicant shall go to the public notary who will confirm the applicant's written statement that the data on the medical certificate are truthful and valid. Subsequently the notary's signature shall be legalized by the Czech Ministry of Justice and finally the medical certificate shall be legalized by the Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- Copy of a **valid health insurance certificate issued by Thai insurer**, which meets the following criteria (insurance by foreign insurer will not be accepted):
 - cover at least 90 days (from arrival date) or the whole period of stay in Thailand
 - have outpatient benefit in Thailand of not less than 40,000 Thai Baht
 - have inpatient benefit in Thailand of not less than 400,000 Thai Baht
 - cover all medical expenditures including COVID-19 at least 100,000 USD

- **Ticket to and out of Thailand**
- **Proof of finance with the sufficient amount to cover the whole period of stay** (copy of actual bank statement or bank confirmation about actual final balance; in English or Thai language).
- **Evidence of long-stay accommodation in Thailand** for the whole period of stay in Thailand (after completing the Alternative Quarantine/SHA+ hotel stay), in English or Thai language, either:
 - A fully-paid **hotel reservation** in Thailand for the whole duration of intended stay in Thailand. The reservation must be issued by the hotel showing the duration of stay, and hotel's contact details and tax ID number;
 - A fully-paid **residential lease** in Thailand for the whole duration of intended stay in Thailand. The lease must be issued by the lessor showing the duration of stay, and the lessor's contact details and tax ID number;
 - **A hire-purchase or mortgage agreement of immovable property**; OR
 - **Condominium title deed.**
- **Visa fee: 1600 CZK** (paid in cash)

Once the visa is issued travellers must register for Thailand Pass at tp.consular.go.th at least 7 days prior to departure. Without the Thailand Pass QR Code, they will be refused entry to Thailand.
